## MINISTRY LEADER PROFILE

**Randy Adams**

Senior Bible Teacher  
Washington, D.C.



In October 2025, Dr. Randy Adams answered the call to serve as Senior Bible Teacher for Capitol Ministries in Washington, D.C. In this capacity, he will lead weekly Bible studies for leaders in the House, Senate, and White House Cabinet, as well as for U.S. Governors.

Dr. Adams has served on the Capitol Ministries Board of Directors for many years, faithfully contributing to the ministry's vision and growth. He steps into this role following Ralph Drollinger's decision to retire from his position after 29 years of leadership.

"When D.C. Members or Governors go to committee hearings on whatever subject, they expect to hear from the best in the world on a given

**I. THE INTRODUCTION OF FAITH**

The biblical injunction to the believer relative to faith means we are to both pioneer and build the kingdom of God by taking risks. To *please Him*, we must obediently step outside of our comfort zone and journey into territories perhaps presently unfamiliar.

The primary reason Jesus keeps us here  
post-salvation is to build His kingdom.

This directive is depicted by Jesus' last words  
to the disciples when He said, "*Go therefore and  
make disciples of all the nations*" (Matthew 28:19).

Notice the word *go* (*poreuthentes*). Jesus is not merely making a suggestion for His followers' consideration. He is commanding them to do this in an ongoing sense as an ingredient necessary to *make disciples* (which is the main verb in the Great Commission). Specifically, the word *go* was used by a civil judge in biblical times to mark the close of a court case.<sup>1</sup> Once the facts were in and the verdict rendered, all who were involved were to *go* and live according to the facts. In parallel, if Jesus rose from the dead and is validly the Messiah (in Matthew this commanding passage is found after the resurrection), then the conclusion is to *go* and tell the world!

Look up the following passages that expand upon this command.

*"You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and that your fruit would remain, so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name He may give to you"* (John 15:16).

*Just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him.* (Ephesians 1:4).

*Now all these things are from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation, namely, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed to us the word of reconciliation. Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were making an appeal through us; we beg you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God* (2 Corinthians 5:18–20).

Who is the believer, and what is he or she to do?

This action of continually *going* (*going* is a participle in the Greek) requires continual faith. And the faith to *go* represents the very essence of fulfilling our identity and calling in Christ. Not to *go* is to self-abort God's mission in every believer's life. Accordingly,

**The question for the believer is not “whether”  
he should go; rather, “where and when?”**

The need to *go* and develop ministries among public servants throughout the world is easily seen by the evidence depicting the moral deficiencies in this people group. Consider the following statistics relative to our United States Congress:

The *Washington Post* reported in 2015 that more than two dozen members of Congress had been indicted since 1980, involving multiple counts of the following:

- Racketeering
- Child pornography
- Aggravated criminal sexual abuse of a child
- Sexual charges
- Misappropriation of funds
- Bribery
- Accepting bribes
- Soliciting bribes in return for official favors
- Mail fraud
- Wire fraud
- Filing false tax returns
- Conspiracy
- Money laundering

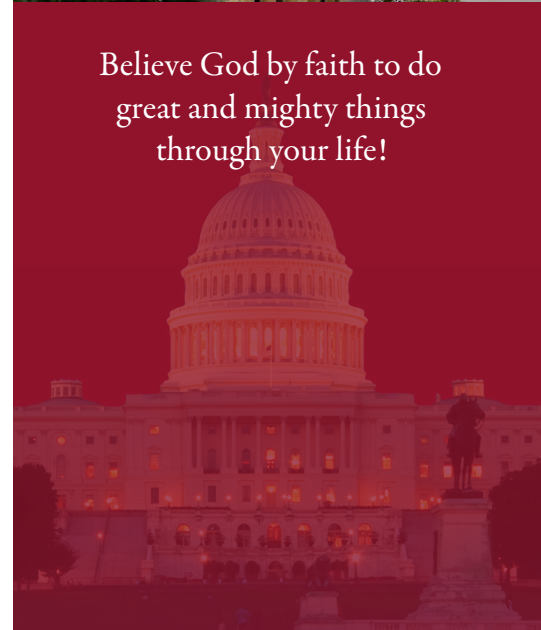

subject. Randy meets that criterion as a deep, wonderful, pastoral Bible teacher who stands on the inerrant, infallible, plenary inspired, authoritative, immutable Word of God. I am so blessed that God has raised him up for this ministry!” concluded Ralph Drollinger.

Prior to assuming this position, Dr. Adams served for 12 years as Executive Director–Treasurer of the Northwest Baptist Convention, following 27 years of pastoral ministry and leadership in missions and evangelism.

“My goal in Washington, D.C., is simple,” he shared. “To teach God’s Word to men and women in leadership and help them apply it in their work, their families, and their daily lives.”

For Dr. Adams, the mission of Capitol Ministries—to make disciples of Jesus Christ—aligns deeply with his convictions.

“I believe in the biblical truth that we must reach leaders,” he said. “Capitol Ministries isn’t about lobbying or politics; it’s about discipleship—teaching leaders the Word of God, leading them to Christ, and helping them grow in biblical

These statistics are so heartbreaking because the most influential people in our culture lack an effective life-changing ministry of the Gospel.<sup>3</sup> They reveal that believers have not *gone* and *made disciples*. It is Capitol Ministries’ goal to fill this evangelistic gap and build strong biblical ministries on the Hill by *making disciples*. What a huge difference the light of the Word can make in any affinity group! But it starts with a willingness to *go* by faith!

The writer of Hebrews employs an athletic metaphor echoing the need of every believer to *go* most efficiently by faith and make disciples: *let us also lay aside every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us* (Hebrews 12:1). What specifically is faith?

## II. THE INTERPRETATION OF FAITH

Hebrews 11:1 interprets or defines biblical faith: *Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen* (KJV). This passage is written in the style of the Old Testament Psalms, which incorporates Hebrew poetry—stating the same thing twice, each stanza in a slightly different manner.

**Substance** (*hupostasis*) means “a standing under.” It connotes “a title deed or a guarantee.” It is the assurance of reality. The Greek word for the phrase *of things hoped for* holds a different meaning than the phrase in contemporary English, as though the biblical writer is describing a whimsical, self-fulfilling desire that he might possess—as if faith is the vehicle by which we get what we want.<sup>4</sup> Rather, in context to the whole of Scripture, it is best understood as those things God places on our hearts in concert with His written, divine will. The following should provide clarity and application.

Psalm 37:4 states, *Delight yourself in the LORD; And He will give you the desires of your heart.* In Philippians 2:13 Paul says to believers, *for it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure.* Both of these passages reveal that God directs believers in and through their hearts. It, therefore, follows that if the direction is from Him, it will always be toward His purposes and glory. This concept is further amplified by Paul in 2 Thessalonians 1:11–12, where he says to the believers at that church, *To this end also we pray for you always, that our God will count you worthy of your calling, and fulfill every desire for goodness ... so that the name of our Lord Jesus will be glorified in you.* In other words, because of the indwelling Holy Spirit, that which the believer *hopes for* is synonymous with his internal *desire for goodness* and God’s glory.

**Faith is the present assurance of a future reality (which God has placed on your heart and is in harmony with Scripture), which He intends to do through you in the future.**

With this biblical definition of faith, you might be uneasy when you hear someone say, “God told me”—only to hear that what He supposedly said is outside the revealed will and purposes of God! God’s will as manifested through His servants is primarily related to redeeming lost sinners from the wrath due them because of a lack of faith in the substitutionary atonement of His Son, Jesus Christ. If what you are believing God has laid on your heart does not somehow include this element, then is your desire from Him, or is it simply one of your selfish desires—and has nothing to do with Him?

**Believe God by faith to do great and mighty things through your life relative to propagating the message of salvation, and you will be in for a fulfilling adventure surpassed by nothing else.**

truth that transforms their lives and decisions.”

Dr. Adams was born in Idaho and raised in Montana. His ministerial service is extensive. From 2004 to 2013, he directed the missions and evangelism team for the Baptist General Convention of Oklahoma. Over 19 years, he served three congregations as senior pastor, and during the past 20 years, he has provided interim pastoral leadership to nine additional churches. His preaching ministry has taken him to International Mission Board conferences in Singapore, India, Thailand, the United Arab Emirates, Malawi, and Hong Kong.

His academic credentials include a Bachelor of Science in Petroleum Engineering from Montana Tech (1983), followed by Master of Divinity (1986) and Doctor of Philosophy (1993) degrees from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Fort Worth, Texas. From 2002 to 2012, he served on the Board of Trustees of Golden Gate Baptist Theological Seminary, including a term as Board Chairman from 2009 to 2011. He also serves as an adjunct professor, teaching courses in preaching, evangelism and leadership.

Dr. Adams' scholarly and ministry-related publications include numerous articles on leadership, missions, evangelism, and preaching. Among them are "Preaching from 1 & 2 Thessalonians," published in the Southwestern Journal of Theology, and Following Jesus from the Beginning, a workbook for new believers that forms part of the MY316 evangelism materials developed under his guidance.

Dr. Adams and his wife, Paula, are the parents of two sons. They will be traveling weekly from their home in Washington State to Washington, D.C., to lead Bible studies with leaders in the House, Senate, and White House Cabinet.

"Every ministry I've ever been called to, we've felt was a joint calling," Dr. Adams said. "Wherever Paula is, I'm home."

Dr. Adams encourages fellow believers to partner with them in prayer and support as they begin this new chapter of ministry.

### III. THE INFUSION OF FAITH

The faith spoken of in Scripture is not derived from ourselves. The ability to trust in Christ for salvation and the ability to believe in Him for future ministry expansion are the result of His infusion of faith (cf. Romans 3:20–26; Galatians 2:16). Ephesians 2:8 states that faith *is the gift of God*. Hebrews 12:2 states, *Fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith*.

The word *author* (*archegos*) means "originator, source or initiator." The *Author* of life infuses us with His life at the time of our salvation. In this regard, Paul stated to the Galatian church, *"I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God"* (2:20).

In a full-picture sense, the believer remains on earth post-salvation to accomplish all that God intends, and to the degree that he is obedient to follow God's promptings, he will achieve his life purpose. For this reason, Paul could confidently say at the end of his ministry and life, *I have fought the good fight, I have finished the course, I have kept the faith* (2 Timothy 4:7). Elsewhere in Ephesians 2:10 he states classically,

*For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.*

The question then becomes are you willing to fulfill the *Author's* preordained purposes for your life?

### IV. THE ILLUSTRATIONS OF FAITH

The following are biblical illustrations of men and women who walked by faith. But first is the classic illustration of faith. *By faith we understand that the worlds were prepared by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things which are visible* (Hebrews 11:3).

Herein we see that God created everything out of things not visible: faith. He has given us that same kind of ability—an ability called faith to possess mental convictions about things He wants accomplished and then the ability and power via the indwelling Holy Spirit to work toward their actual accomplishment! Such a God-given ability can consume your whole life!

Nothing is more exciting than to look back and see how God matured a particular person or a ministry through obedient faith. It is very fulfilling!

How do the following Old Testament saints illustrate faith in the sense of Hebrews 11:1? *Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.*





#### A. NOAH

*By faith Noah, being warned by God about things not yet seen, in reverence prepared an ark for the salvation of his household, by which he condemned the world, and became an heir of the righteousness which is according to faith (Hebrews 11:7).*

#### B. ABRAHAM

*By faith Abraham, when he was called, obeyed by going out to a place which he was to receive for an inheritance; and he went out, not knowing where he was going (Hebrews 11:8).*

#### C. SARAH

*By faith even Sarah herself received ability to conceive, even beyond the proper time of life, since she considered Him faithful who had promised (Hebrews 11:11).*

#### D. MOSES

*By faith they passed through the Red Sea as though they were passing through dry land; and the Egyptians, when they attempted it, were drowned (Hebrews 11:29).*

#### E. JOSHUA

*By faith the walls of Jericho fell down after they had been encircled for seven days (Hebrews 11:30).*

#### V. THE INTENTION OF FAITH

Lastly, in studying faith we learn, *And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him* (Hebrews 11:6).

We will never know salvation by reason, calculation, merit, or achievement. Nor will we ever experience the richness of having God use our lives until by faith we will yield.
